



Work internship and on-the-job-training as a lifesaving rescue worker. Gaining skill & knowledge & competences, which are summed up in the Unit of Learning Outcomes „Search and Rescue in the Field“.

27AJOB-RELATED SKILLS

The student:

- can determine the priorities for ensuring people's safety during crisis situations, can demonstrate and describe the process of ensuring people's safety at the site of the accident;
- can construct an improvised shelter, procure sufficient amount of fluids, and start a fire;
- can put the casualties into the recovery position (when their extremities, pelvis, or spine have been injured);
- can perform and describe first aid for traumatic injuries (extremities, spine, abdomen);
- can find a pulse and perform resuscitation in the event the patient stops breathing;
- can immobilise broken bones with limited supplies;
- can organise a transfer of the casualties, comprehensively describe their condition and call for professional help;
- can justify the selection of supplies for providing preliminary medical aid and demonstrate their use;
- can describe self-rescue techniques in calm/wild water, can demonstrate techniques of rescuing a drowning person (model situation);
- can lower down or pull up casualties using ropes (munter hitch).

28ALANGUAGE SKILLS

Development of the language competences in English language, vocabulary and phrases development, improving speech fluency, at B1 level – to be able to communicate during lifesaving missions.
